One Flu Over the Cuckoo's Nest



"By April 10, only *BuzzFeed* among the white-dominated news outlets reported the disproportionate rates of deaths among African Americans from COVID-19. Their statistics were shocking. In Chicago, blacks make up 30% of the population but 70% of the COVID-19 deaths. In Louisiana, blacks are 32% of the population and 70% of COVID deaths. In Michigan, blacks comprised 14% of the population but 52% of deaths. In Mississippi, blacks comprise 38% of the population and 71% of the deaths.
