TWO WAYS TO QUALIFY

You or your parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must have performed seasonal agriculture labor (fieldwork, packing house, dairies, poultry/live stock production, fishing) for at least 75 days within the past two years;

OR

Participation in the Migrant Education Program (MEP) anytime during high school.

WHAT IS C.A.M.P.?

C.A.M.P. is a federally funded program designed to provide support and retention services to students who have been admitted to the University and are either migrant or from farmworking families.
