

Proposed Amendments to the  
Undergraduate Policies and Procedures: Majors and Minors

The following amendment was proposed by Senator L. Kensinger, 10/3/11

To alter the 'Adding a Minor' section to remove language in strikeout and include the language in red font:

**Adding a Minor**

Students can add a minor only if they can complete both their major and the minor within 144 earned units. ~~Student requests to add a minor must be approved by the department offering the minor indicating that the student has been advised.~~ Students may declare a minor by completing the appropriate form and receiving advising and approval if required by the Department. If the student has 90 or more earned units, the request must be signed by the Department offering the minor indicating the student has been advised. ~~accompanied by a plan demonstrating that the minor can be completed within 144 units.~~

The following amendment is proposed by Senator H. Chapman, 10/3/11

To add the following sentence to the end of the 'Maximum Number of Majors and Minors' section at line 16:

A student will be allowed 54 high school Advanced Placement (AP) and other similar units (IB and CLEP) in addition to the maximum of 144 earned units.
