## HOW TO PREPARE YOUR BIO FOR THE PROGRAM

Include these items in your bio as appropriate

- 1. Name as it is to appear in the program.
- 2. Role(s) or Duties in parenthesis. Ex: (Alexander Hamilton) or (Costume Designer)
- 3. **Major** with a dash to indicate emphasis. Ex: Theatre Arts Acting or Music Composition
- 4. Expected graduation year or rank in school. Ex: Freshmen or "expects to graduate in 2020"
- 5. If a freshmen or transfer student, high school or other college attended.
- 6. Hometown, if NOT from Fresno or Clovis.
- 7. **Previous Shows** you have participated in, up to four. If not University Theatre shows, indicate production company. *PUT SHOW TITLES IN ITALICS. Ex. Hamilton* at The Public Theatre or The Public Theatre's production of *Hamilton*.
- 8. Affiliations, such as professional or student organization, sorority/fraternity, etc.
- 9. Name of any **theatre arts scholarships** received. Ex: Gus Graham Technical Theatre Scholarship, Ray Ensher Sholarship, etc.

**Hegina Rarris** (*Lighting Designer*) is a junior Theatre Arts – Design/Tech major. She was an assistant lighting designer for University Theatre's *Be More Chill*. In 2014, she was sound designer for *Wicked* at Oregon Shakespeare Festival. Hegina is a recipient of the Gus Graham Technical Theatre Scholarship.

## STYLE GUIDE

- Bios should be no more than three grammatically correct sentences.
- Format your bio in FULL sentences.
- Use a dash to indicate the concentration, emphasis or option in your major.
- Use "Fresno State" not CSUF, FSU, State, CSU Fresno or Cal State Fresno.
- Titles of show should be in italics.
- Do NOT thank people or deities in the program.
- If you have a list of productions, use commas to separate ALL of them.
